Dear JACK T HOOVER Mr,

The current balance of your unemployment insurance overpayment is \$823.27. N.C. Gen. Stat. § 143-553 provides that employees of the State and certain local education systems, nonsalaried public officials and legislators who owe money to the State of North Carolina must make full restitution of the amount owed as a condition of continued employment. This statute also requires the employer to provide written notice to the employee of their obligation to make restitution. If, after a reasonable time, the employee has not paid the obligation in full or begun satisfactory repayment, the employer shall take steps to terminate employment unless the employee is pursuing administrative or judicial remedy.

To avoid involving your employer in this recovery effort, refund the amount of the overpayment on or before September 1, 2018. You may go online at <u>des.nc.gov</u> and make a onetime payment, or send a check/money order payable to the **North Carolina Division of Employment Security** to the address listed below. Please include the last four digits of your Social Security Number on your check or money order.
